As artists, we are learning to sketch a front self-portrait.

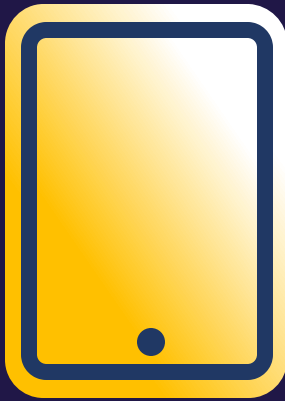
As artists, we are learning to understand primary and secondary colours.
