Spending money

Medical and Medication

For our trip:

- Medical forms must be completed before we go.
- Medication to be placed into a named bag or container and given to the designated first aider on the morning we leave.
- Travel sickness – please let us know if your child suffers from travel sickness so we can sit them appropriately on the coach. If they take a tablet for this, a medical form must be completed and the medication box given to the first aider.
- Asthma – please ensure named inhalers are in school for us to take with us
- Allergies – please let us know of any changes to any information we already have regarding allergies.
